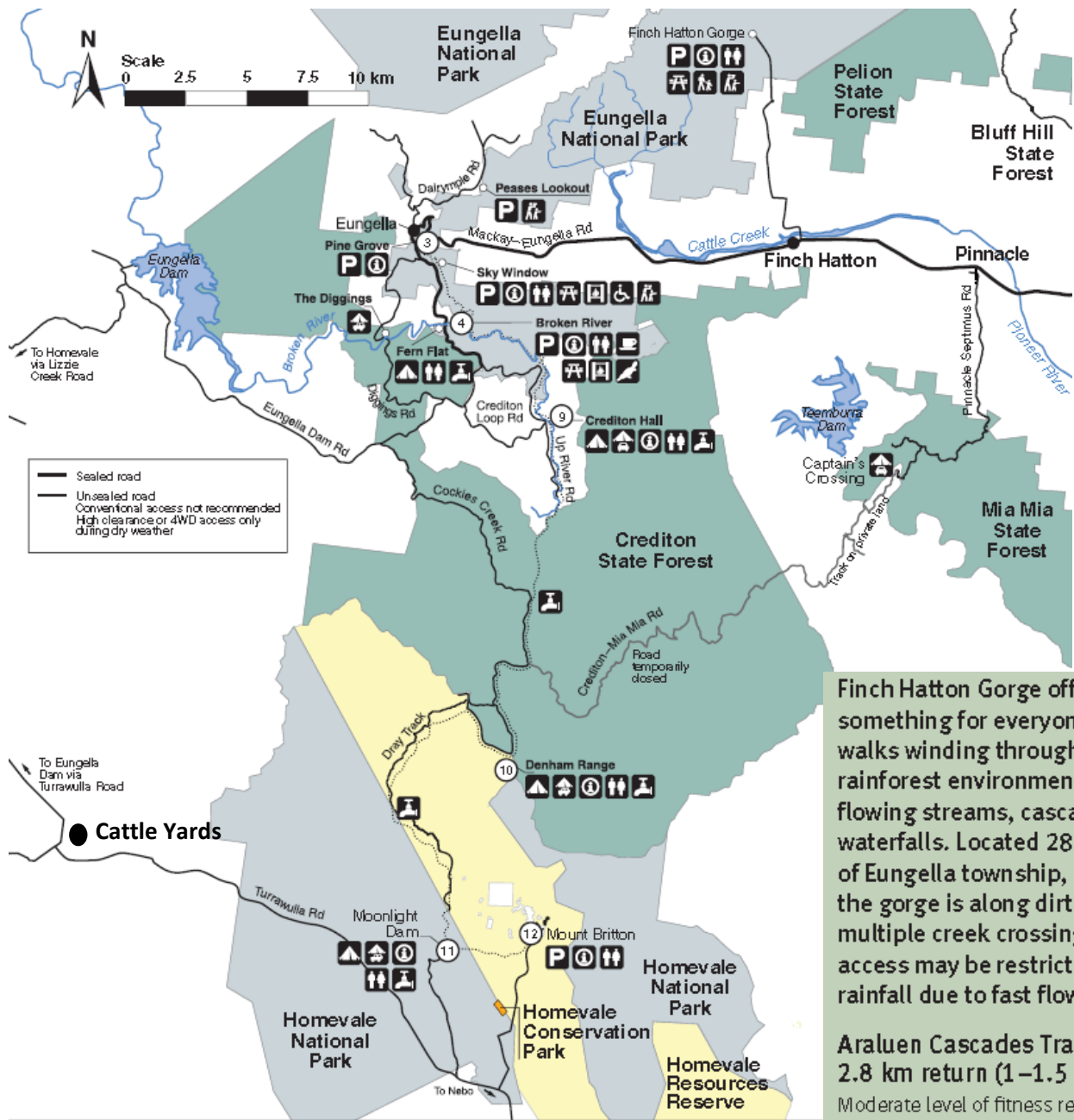


SCENIC DRIVES and CAMPING OPPORTUNITIES



Eungella to Diggins (4WD) 8.5km one way
Diggins to Quarry (Eungella Dam Road) 7km one way
Eungella to Broken River 5km one way
Eungella to Crediton Hall 15km one way
Eungella Dam to Turrawulla Cattle Yards 17.5km
 (left Lizzie Creek Rd / Pipeline Road)
Turrawulla Cattle Yards to Collinsville 112km
 (right Nebo / Turrawulla Road)
Turrawulla Cattle Yards to Nebo 76km
 (left Nebo / Turrawulla Road)

Finch Hatton Gorge offers something for everyone with short walks winding through a complex rainforest environment with fast flowing streams, cascades and waterfalls. Located 28 km east of Eungella township, access to the gorge is along dirt roads with multiple creek crossings. Vehicle access may be restricted after high rainfall due to fast flowing streams.

Araluen Cascades Track
2.8 km return (1–1.5 hours)
 Moderate level of fitness required for short uphill sections. From Finch Hatton Gorge parking area, walk through lush rainforest and between large granite boulders to the lookout above the Araluen Cascades.

Wheel of Fire Track
4.2 km return (1.5–2 hours)
 Moderate level of fitness required for uphill sections and a long section of stairs. Leaving from the parking area, turn off from Araluen Cascades Track to walk to a large rock pool. Callistemon Crossing is a particularly rewarding place to sit among the palms.

At Wheel of Fire, choose a comfortable boulder, take a seat and cool off before walking 2.1 km back to the parking area.
